What's Being On A Novice Cheer Team Like?:

Novice Cheer is great for athletes who are usually beginners and are somewhat new to Cheer. It's a great level to learn the basics. This level is similar to Rec but these teams will go to competition. This level accommodates a wide range of skill levels and experience and is a great introduction to Cheer who also want to experience the Competition environment.

This is for athletes who are looking to start on the path to Competitive Cheer with a more relaxed approach that allows athletes to develop their skills at a pace that's more comfortable for them.

Teams prepare to perform at our 2 shows as well as 1-2 additional performance opportunities AND 2 local Competitions. . Many athletes may eventually continue onto the Prep level.

Novice Cheer season runs from September-May (9 months).

There is emphasis on teamwork, the fundamentals of cheer, beginner tumbling, physical fitness, flexibility, proper nutrition and positive attitudes.

For us to reach our goals we emphasize building a foundation on safety, technique, and repetition. These basics help develop a sense of trust between athletes and reinforces the importance of safety as they train to acquire new skills.

We strive to develop the habits of working hard, developing physical strength, mental focus, self-discipline, and a desire to gain and master new skills.

We embrace the fun challenges together and encourage each team member to keep working to realize their potential.

*** Commitment to the Novice level team must be made by September 1st. We will begin choreography at the beginning of September to prepare for competition. ***

EXPECTATIONS IN PRACTICE

PRACTICE

- Novice Cheer will have One 1 hour, 15 minute cheer practice a week \$71 / month. Total commitment = 1 hour, 15 minutes weekly.
- **ALL Novice Athletes must have a current debit or credit card on file with us in the Parent Portal/JackRabbit at all times.**
- Practice starts at the scheduled time. **ARRIVE EARLY.** Athletes must be in the gym, with hair up and shoes on at the start of practice. No jewelry!
- All potential Absences should be communicated to Jill so we can plan accordingly.
- Practice/Starstruck wear is to be worn to all team practices. When you look like a team you practice like a team!
- **Quitting policy – Any athlete that quits after choreography will be charged an additional \$100 cancellation fee. Before committing please consider the requirements of being a Novice athlete.**

Athlete Conduct



ATHLETE CONDUCT, SOCIAL MEDIA , BRAND & LOGO POLICIES

Starstruck athletes are not allowed to participate in activities at other All Star Cheerleading Gyms.

SOCIAL MEDIA:

At Starstruck we take pride in our gym and aim to hold ourselves and our athletes to a high standard and feel it's very important to represent yourself well on social media. We approach social media seriously and monitor how the Starstruck name, brand, logo, and likeness are used. We maintain the right to curate and request removal of items from social media sites and Apps that are deemed to be unsafe, inappropriate or in conflict with Starstruck's conduct standards

Anything that is aimed to bully, embarrass, or degrade any individual or group of individuals, including the use of profanity, and/or content that is overly provocative is unacceptable. Please remember anything you post online affects not only you, but also your teammates and Starstruck as a whole.

We want our athletes and families to wear Starstruck attire with pride in public and in social media posts to show support and to promote a positive public image. **Avoid posting any negative comments on social media.** When experiencing strong feelings there is a right way and a wrong way to resolve them. Generally speaking, taking those feelings to social media in the heat of the moment is not the solution and often creates more problems than it solves. If any issues should arise please schedule a meeting with Jill to discuss.

We request that Athletes at Starstruck avoid use of any accounts linked to an anonymous platform. In other words, don't use "burner accounts" to interact with Starstruck or Starstruck athlete social media. We've found this helps to diminish instances of cyber bullying, encourages students to use their real accounts to communicate with one another, and promotes more responsible online behaviors and interactions.

Should Starstruck request removal of, including but not limited to, photos, video, status, comment, etc removal must take place IMMEDIATELY. Repeated violations of conduct standards may be grounds for dismissal from Starstruck without refund. We greatly appreciate your cooperation in supporting our efforts to provide a level of reasonable supervision and decorum.

BRAND AND LOGO POLICIES:

Do not make your own Starstruck items

FUNDRAISING

Each of the fundraises we utilize have been successful. We've been able to identify a variety of fundraising products from different vendors that resonate with people so we're not just offering one thing all year long. Many Starstruck students have repeat buyers they visit every year who continue to support our fundraising efforts.

Historically athletes who have participated in multiple fundraisers were able to fund a significant portion of their cheerleading expenses, particularly for post season competition. I've also learned parents are much less stressed and tend to enjoy their season a lot more.

We have a number of current fundraisers but are always looking for new opportunities and volunteer leadership.

Payment Policy



Billing and Payments:

- It is required that all members create a Starstruck Account via Jackrabbitch.com to pay tuition and related expenses.
- You must have a valid payment method on file to participate – credit card, debit card or checking account.
- All payments will be made through this online system.
- Payments will be taken out on the scheduled due dates.
- Monthly tuition will be withdrawn on the 1st of every month using the billing information you entered when setting up your account.
- Refunds: Monthly charges, competitions, pay in full, or items purchased are non-refundable and non-transferable. Please make sure you have thought your expenses through prior to starting the season. All expenses are still due even if ill, injured, or you choose to quit. Refunds on these situations, but not limited to, will not be issued.
- Pay in Full: A 10% discount of tuition will be given to those who choose to pay the year in full. Pay in full will be due July 1st. Choreography payment will still be the due date listed above if not already paid in full. Competition fees will not be included. Pay in full is non refundable and non transferable.

ACCOUNT BALANCES:

All fees must be paid on time. Account balance must be Paid In Full one week before date of Competition. If it's not paid, your athlete doesn't compete. This policy will be enforced.

If a successful payment has not been processed by the 10th of the month, a \$35 late fee will be applied. \$30 fee for all returned checks.
